League Guidelines

As we approach the start of the Summer Season, bowlers joining league teams for the first time might appreciate some guidance with regard to the roles that apply to each position in the team.

Fours teams are made up as follows:-

Lead – Places the mat and bowls the jack - <u>if last end won</u>.

Collects the bowls and takes them back behind the mat - if last end lost.

Second – Keeps score – home team keeps the card, away team changes board. Always agree card and board between you to avoid errors.

Third – Measures for shot, where needed, and decide/agrees the number of shots with the opponent third <u>only thirds are allowed to do this</u>. All other players on the rink should stand well behind the head and <u>not</u> take part, or comment, on the decision made.

Skip – The Skip is in charge of the team as director. The skip instructs the Lead, Second and Third as to what the game plan is and how to play shots with the best chance of producing a score for the team. The Third advises the Skip.

The Summer Season Leagues are mostly Triples:-

In triples games the roles of second and third are merged, meaning that the second marks the score card <u>and</u> measures for shot. However, marking of the scorecard can be allocated to another player.


